CIRCULAR

Sub: Guidelines for Admission in Class-XI in Science, Commerce, Humanities and Vocational Streams for the session 2023-24 in ATAL ADARSH VIDYALYAS

NDMC has decided to open the admissions to Class XI in all Atal Adarsh Vidyalayas for the session 2023-24 for the Students who have passed Class X from Delhi Government/Government Aided/NDMC/Delhi Cantonment Board Schools/any other board are eligible for admission in Class XI in AAV Schools in terms of GNCTD Circular No. DE.23 (28)/Sch.Br./2023/Dated:16/05/2023 (**attached**).

2. HOS shall adhere the following Admission Criteria for Class XI and Instructions regarding Admission in Class XI -

Admission Criteria for Class XI & Instructions regarding Admission in Class XI

(i) Students declared passed in the Secondary School Examination will be considered for admission in any stream of Class XI subject to the following eligibility criteria: -

Science (With Maths)	55%	English-50%	Standard Maths/Basics Maths/Maths-50%	Science-50%
Science (Without Maths)	55%	English-50%	Standard Maths/Basics Maths/Maths-40%	Science-50%
Commerce (With Maths)	50%	English-45%	Standard Maths/Basics Maths/Maths-50%	Social Science-45%

Humanities	<p>A student must have been declared pass at the Secondary School Examination by the CBSE or its equivalent board.</p> <p>For giving Economics as a subject, a student must have, at least, 45% in aggregate.</p> <p>For giving Mathematics as a subject, a student must have secured, at least, 50% in Mathematics.</p> <p>Note: Admission in Humanities is not to be denied to own students who have been declared pass in Class-X examination.</p>

(ii) Relaxation of 5% marks will be given in any one of the three subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream to the candidates belonging to the categories SC/ST/Minorities/OBC (Non Creamy Layer)/Kashmiri Migrants & those students having I/II/III position in National Games.

(iii) For specially Abled Students, relaxation of 5% marks in all subjects mentioned for admission in particular stream is to be given.

(iv) Age relaxation as per circular No. DE.23 (363)/School Br./2016/1553, dated - 19-09-16 may be followed by all schools **(attached)**.

(v) The HOS must also ensure that the students fulfill the subject-wise eligibility criteria for admission in Class XI as per required percentage of marks, at Secondary Examination (Class X).

(vi) In this regard, the Heads of Schools must ensure that all the eligible students of their OWN SCHOOL are given admission. Only after all the students of OWN SCHOOL have been admitted and if seats are vacant then the HOS will consider the students from outside. HOS shall ensure that students from feeder schools of NDMC get admission on priority as per eligibility criteria.

(vii) Application form along with filled option form for such admission is to be submitted by the students directly in the school.

(viii) The marks of the concerned students must be properly checked and verified by the Head of School before granting admission.



(ix) Heads of Schools will ensure that all eligible and willing students of own school and feeder schools of NDMC are granted admission in Science/Commerce/Humanities Stream and no eligible student will be denied admission till the completion of the Admission Process on the pretext of Non-Availability of Seats.

(x) HOS will ensure that at least 20 students get enrolled in particular stream/subject.

3. HOS will ensure compliance of admission guidelines & instructions as above.
